2. Qualifications:

or

2) An Existing Customer must be in financial distress as determined by the Company.

3. Definitions:

Existing Firm Manufacturing Customer - Owner or tenant of a premises who has received service under the Company's firm tariffs for a period of twelve (12) months or longer, and is classified by the Standard Industrial Classification No. 20-39.

4. Terms & Conditions:

Customer must meet the following conditions prior to the Company's rendering of service under this rider:

- Customer must contact the Connecticut Economic Resource Center for potential participation in other Economic Development programs.
 - 2) Customer agrees to implement cost-effective conservation measures through; the C.E.R.C. economic development programs, the customer undertaking the conservation measures individually, or through the Company's existing conservation programs.

The service rendered under this rider shall be subject to the terms, conditions, and regulations of the firm rate to which the customer would otherwise be subject.

5. Rate Per Month

Supply service: All components of the applicable firm tariff Supply Service shall be charged at the full tariff rate and shall not be discounted. This restriction applies to both the Third-Party Supplier Service Option and the Company Supply Service Option.

6. Term of Service:

The service as defined under these riders shall not exceed five (5) years in length.

7. Service Regulations:

The Company's Service Rules and Regulations shall apply to service under this Rider MED, to the extent not inconsistent with the terms and conditions of this Rider MED.
